# PHASE-II

Select  
Course

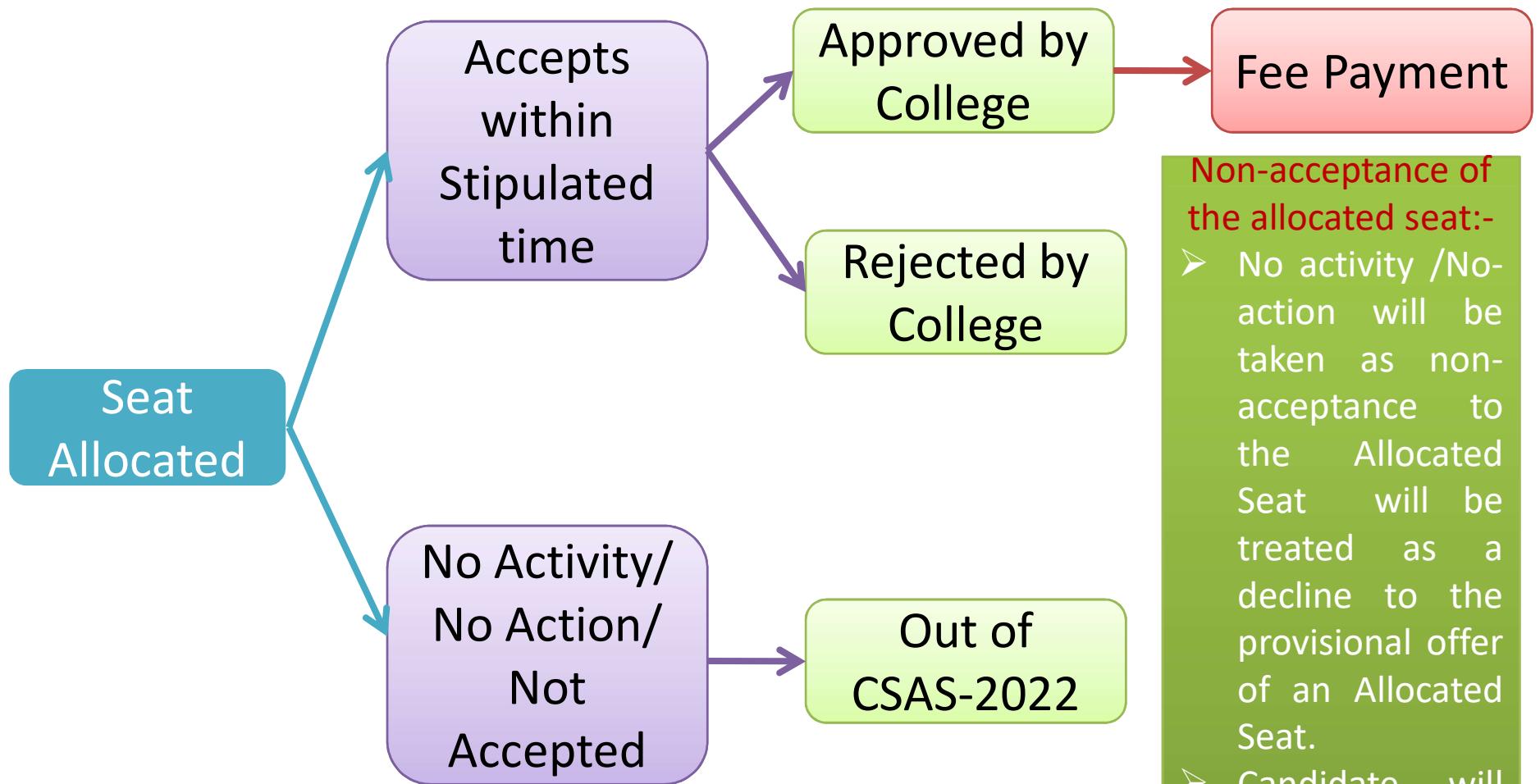
- Candidates need to select the courses in which they want admission in order of preference

Select  
Colleges

- Candidates need to select the colleges in which they want admission in order of preference

Seat  
Allocated

- On the basis of **CUET Normalised score** they will be automatically allotted seat in course and college according to their merit



**Non-acceptance of the allocated seat:-**

- No activity /No-action will be taken as non-acceptance to the Allocated Seat will be treated as a decline to the provisional offer of an Allocated Seat.
- Candidate will no longer be able to participate in the subsequent rounds of CSAS-2022.

Important:- In order to be considered for upgradation in the subsequent rounds a candidate **must "Accept"** the allocated seat.

Freeze  
/Upgrade

- In next round of admission, candidates can choose to **Freeze** the seat or **Upgrade** to their next possible combination

Mid Level  
Entry

- Candidates will also be allowed mid level entry after two rounds at a charge of Rs 1000/-

Role of  
College

- There is No cut off by the colleges. Colleges will need to check the certificates
