


SASHAKT SOCIETY REPORT ANDC 2020-2021



- Internal Complaints Committee is a body of college which works to deal with cases of Sexual harassment with any student/staff/ any female member who is a part of the college. Any girl if she feels she is being disturbed by anyone, she can contact any of the member of ICC and express her issues and then ICC will call proper query upon the matter to take strict actions against the person who is found responsible for the charges
- The ICC and Proctor goes hand in hand and equally holds power to take strict actions if any of one is found responsible for the charged misconduct, hence ensure that your behavior never hurt other's sentiment
- These bodies are not to frighten you but just to make you aware about how should be your conduct with others and to inculcate discipline in oneself.
