General/B.Sc(Hons)/ /B.S. /Int. M.Sc. /Int. M.Sc. or M.Sc. examinations every academic year, failing which the scholarship for the next academic year will not be released. 

- 3. Convenor, Fellowship Programme and Award Committee.
- 4. Donor or one person nominated by the donor or any other member of the family

Quorum for the above Committee shall be four members including donor or one person nominated by the donor or any other member of the family. As far as possible, decision will be taken unanimously by the Committee. Whenever the nominee of the family is not able to attend the meeting. Nominee or the donor shall always be intimated about the decision of the Committee.

Criterion for granting Scholarship shall be

- 1. Merit is the first criteria, meaning student scoring the higher gets the priority.
- 2. Minimum merit score should be 70% and above.
- 3. Their family income is less than Rs. 20,000 per month.
- 4. The scholarship shall be exclusively for needy girl student.
