Minutes of the meeting

Agenda item 1.

Introductory overview of IOAC, its objectives, functions and benefits for a Higher Education Institute (HEI) before the newly constituted IOAC team by coordinator of IOAC.

The Coordinator of the cell formally welcomed all the members of IQAC and introduced the External member Dr. Bharti Sarkar to the IQAC team. The Chairperson expressed sincere thanks to the External Member for being the member of IQAC team.

The meeting started with the brief introduction about National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The importance of accountability and transparency was underlined to assure quality in a Higher Educational Institute (HEI) coupled with goals, functions and benefits of Quality Cell.

Agenda item 2.

Documentation of the various programs/activities of the College, leading to quality maintenance and improvement

Dr. Bharti Sarkar expressed her views regarding importance of official documentation. She elaborated on the purpose of documentation as they are the source or repository of the entire activities that take place in any organization, therefore documentation needs to be scientifically recorded, sorted and analyzed. It provides assurance that quality related activities are being executed the way these were planned and approved. Coordinator, IQAC expressed his serious concern and stressed on the improvement in keeping of file records and documents in order to bring transparency at ANDC.

A committee to be constituted to draft the Annual Quality Assurance Report (AOAR) for the year 2018-19

All members were informed by the coordinator that Annual Quality Assurance Reports (AQAR 2016-17 & AQAR 2017-18) had been submitted to NAAC. AQAR report for the year 2018-19 to be drafted and submitted by the second week of November 2019. In this regard, a subcommittee within the IQAC was constituted to complete the draft by the 15th September 2019 as per the prescribed format of the IQAC. Assessment and evaluation of application of quality parameters for the various academic and administrative activities of the College.

- i. The Chairperson informed members about the various programs running in the college to provide better facility for teaching–learning environment.
- ii. The ERP software (iON Services) purchased in 2014 from TCS (Tata Consultancy Services Ltd) was discussed in detail. Staff members of Accounts and Administration sections have categorically requested Principal ANDC to terminate ERP software (**Letter attached**) and stop further wastage of money nearly @ Rs.1.79 Lakhbeing exhausted every month. The Coordinator, IQAC summarized financial loss of around nearly 1.15 crore since 2014 paid to TCS. He further Dr. expressed his sincere thanks to the Acting Principal, Dr. Ravi Toteja for accepting the demand of college teachers to issue attendance registers. The Acting principal also informed that ERP software has been made by the University of Delhi and it would be made available free to all colleges. All members agreed that ERP needs to be terminated as soon as possible for the better alternatives for all college stakeholders. In this regard, a sub-committee was constituted to find comparatively inexpensive and efficient replacement as per the requirements and immediate needs of the college stakeholders i.e. 2000 students and staff of the college. The Committee

was requested to submit its report by 30th August, 2019. The sub-committee comprises following members;

Though there was a consensus on getting the complete service files scanned till date, but all were in agreement that it would be a tedious job, therefore, the Chairperson suggested that the concerned teacher could scan his/her service till date and later every year scan copy would be sent to all teachers separately. Similarly, for our support staff, their Confidential Reports (CR) also to be streamlined for their information.

- v. Dr. Subhash Kumar recommended that reading section of Library must be open till 8:00 p.m during exam time for our college students.
- vi. Taking into view the increase in the strength of students due to EWS expansion, there is an urgent need to augment the class-room space.

7. The screening committee for the scrutinization of application forms received in the college for the permanent faculty position shall be constituted at the earliest.



IQAC promotes several activities such as seminars, workshops, symposia, conferences, panel discussions and academic meetings Following is the list of activities conducted by IQAC in the last few years:

Activities organized by IQAC in 2021-22

The IQAC members of the college over the last year, undertook many initiatives including guidance of colleges/institutes based on the following points:

- The IQAC members visited Holy Family College of Nursing on September 28, 2021 to guide them about arranging periodic assessment and nuances regarding accreditation besides creating awareness about academic Programmes / projects.
- A meeting with the External Members of IQAC of the college was held on December 15, 2021. Therein the external members were apprised of how a stimulating academic environment for the promotion of quality teaching-learning and research is being maintained in the college despite the rude interruption by the COVID-19 pandemic.

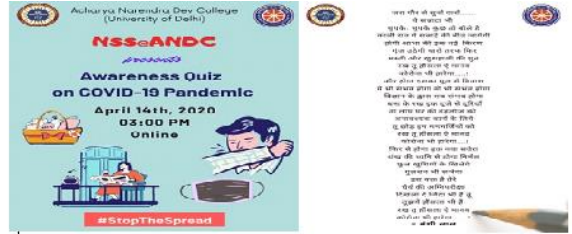

The pandemic imposed several constraints and physical visits to the adopted villages couldn't take place and hence most of the time UBA @ ANDC team worked virtually and remained in contact with the people. Our team interacted with the villagers over phone calls and Whatsapp chat groups. Regular information and updates were shared with them regarding Covid and its necessary protocols for their safety and hygiene. It was only after lock down restrictions were eased a little that UBA volunteers visited these villages and did physical survey.

- On September 20, 2020, the UBA unit of ANDC organised a webinar on NEP 2020 with the NSS unit of the college at Vidyavati Mukand Lal Girls College, Ghaziabad to create awareness among staff and students of the college on New Education Policy 2020.

- The UBA unit of ANDC organised a webinar on NEP 2020 with the NSS unit of the college for UBA and NSS volunteers at ANDC on September 21, 2020 to help them understand the New Education Policy 2020 so that they can create awareness among their friends and classmates. Later on, UBA volunteers organised webinars on NEP 2020, for the Life Science students of ANDC on September 23, 2020 and for the Physical Sciences students of ANDC on September 24, 2020.
- On September 28, 2020, the UBA unit organised a webinar on NEP 2020 with the NSS unit of the college for Rajkiya Balika Inter College, Sector 51, Noida to make the staff and students of the college aware about the New Education Policy 2020.
- In **Breast Cancer Awareness Month**, a webinar was organised by UBA-NSS unit of the college on '*Mera Sangharsh , Meri Jeet, Meri Kahani*' on October 23, 2020. The purpose of the webinar was to inform every woman of the college and all those who had participated that 'The Best Protection is Early Detection' and early the Detection, Longer is the Protection.

- Mrs Kanchan Singh, Former General Secretary, Bhartiya Grameen Mahila Sangh
- Dr Indu Rampal, Former Senior Lecturer at Amity Institute of Corporate Communication.

It was followed by an interactive session with Dr Pawan Mehrotra (ANDC alumini-Department of Biomedical Science) Founder, Aarna Biomedical Products, Creator of Sampooriti-Poorti System for post surgical prosthetic rehabilitation for breast cancer survivors.

- In **Vigilance Awareness Week-2020**, a debate on 'Gender Par Charcha' was organised by the UBA-NSS unit of the college on October 30, 2020. Participants were allowed to express their views on '*Equality is Human Right not Gender Right*'. The idea was to record all the debates and to share the Hindi debates in village Whatsapp groups.
- In **Vigilance Awareness Week-2020**, an article writing competition was organised by the UBA-NSS unit of the college on '*Corruption Free India/ Corruption in India- Choice or Constraint/ Corruption in Government System- Causes and Solutions*' on November 01, 2020. The idea was to share Hindi articles in village Whatsapp groups.
- UBA@ANDC organised '**Hands on training**' for **skill development** of the interested residents of the adopted area, Govindpuri on March 01 and 02, 2021.

During recent visits to the area by UBA volunteers, they discussed the problems faced by the residents to which most of the residents informed that they are struggling for their livelihood as due to corona they do not have any more paid jobs. The purpose of the training program was to help them be self reliant.

In the training program, UBA@ANDC along with the Entrepreneurship Cell of the college, trained them in the preparation of different types of Hand Washes (Liquid Soap). During the program participants were given motivational talk and were also groomed with marketing skills. The participants were also given the set of material required for the preparation of these liquid soaps.

- UBA volunteers created vaccine awareness and persuaded the villagers to get them vaccinated as per the schedule implemented by the Government. They also helped the eligible people to register themselves for vaccination on Cowin/Aarogya Setu applications.
- UBA volunteers took online classes for the children of Okhla and Govind Puri slums. They not only taught them the topics in which they face difficulty but also provided them with sample papers and notes for better understanding of the concept.

Activities under UBA (2021-2022)

UBA@ANDC organized a free Medical Check-up Camp for the residents of the adopted area, Okhla on April 3, 2022 from 10 am to 3 pm. The camp was organized in collaboration with ASTHA (NGO) and Earth Revital Foundation (NGO). ASTHA provided the space and basic infrastructure required for the camp, whereas Earth Revital Foundation provided necessary items to be used in health camp and also PPE kits to health workers. Both the doctors who were available for the consultation during the health camp were invited by Earth Revital Foundation.

All the precautions and protocols to prevent the spread of COVID-19 were well taken care of. Sanitizers were extensively used at the entrance, reception table, consultation tables and patient-examination room. Free masks were distributed to all the residents who came for health check-up. Everyone was asked to wear masks.

The camp was inaugurated by one of the senior most citizen of the area, Ms Kiran Devi. Besides the general health check up in which B.P., oxygen level, pulse, body temperature, proper functioning of heart by stethoscope and weight were measured, Dr Praveen Bharti and Dr Vikram, Medicine Department, AIIMS, New Delhi, checked up 78 residents in the Camp and gave their consultations to them. The purpose of the camp was to make the residents aware about their health and also motivate them to lead a healthier and active lifestyle.

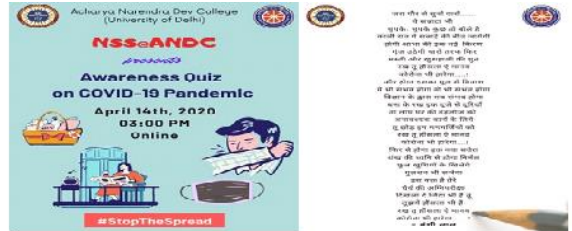

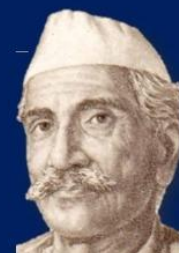

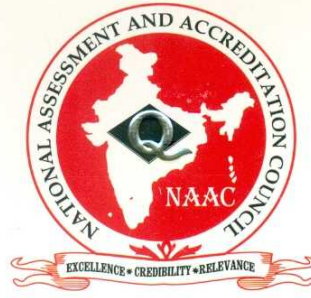
