## **Guidelines of the Anusandhan Kosh**

Grant under Anusandhan Kosh can be availed for the following categories:-

- 1) Grant of non-NET Fellowship (Rs 8,000/- as per university norms) for the candidates registered for Ph.D. program in the college and who are not in receipt of any financial assistance/ salary/ aid of any kind from any funding agency, to enable them to pursue their research, for a period of one year or thesis submission whichever is earlier. This may be assigned to not more than three students at a time and this fund is fixed for the period of one year in his last year of Ph.D. program.
- 2) Maintenance / infrastructural development for research Lab may be assigned up to Rs. 25,000/- per annum. Proposals for the aforementioned would be invited from permanent faculty members of the college by 1st of August every year. The projects will be finalized by 31st or last working day of October of that academic year. A committee duly appointed by the college and consisting of eminent scientists would evaluate the proposals and finalize the same. Also the proposals would be invited in a prescribed format.
- 3) Travel grant for research students may be assigned up to maximum of Rs. 15,000/- per Ph.D. supervisor as per the guidelines formulated for the sanction of travel grant. One student from one supervisor should be eligible for this travel grant per year.

For availing travel grant from Anusandhaan Kosh, students should first apply through his / her contingency and at least one external funding agency. If the application gets rejected then students should apply to Anusandhaan Kosh with proper proof of application being rejected from an external funding agency. The following conditions should be fulfilled by the candidate for availing travel grant:

- The candidate should have presented the paper in a conference/ workshop / seminar.
- The candidate should attach the certificate of participation in conference/ workshop / seminars.

- The prior permission to attend the event must be attached with application.
- The students may be allowed to avail to and fro travel grant of AC three tiers train /Rs. 8,000 /deficit amount of grant received from other funding agencies (whichever is less) for paper presentation in national level conferences and Rs.10,000/-Air fare from Economy class/ deficit amount of grant received from other funding agencies (whichever is less) for paper presentation in international level conferences.
- The prior approval from the principal is must before availing this grant.
- A copy of the acceptance letter from the organizer for the paper presentation should be provided at the time of reimbursement.
- No grant will be availed by the students just to attend the conference.
- Students need to submit their train tickets / boarding pass for to and fro journey to the destination of national / international conference.
- Successful completion certificate of conference along with hard copy of paper presented should be submitted by the students at the time of reimbursement.
- Those students who have already exhausted their contingency from Ph. D. fellowship and have valid registration in Ph.D. are entitled to apply for this grant.
- If the students are applying for a grant from Anusandhan Kosh then their application should be forwarded by their supervisor along with the convener of Anusandhan Kosh.
- If the numbers of applications received for this grant are more, then the students will receive this grant on a first come first served basis.
- 4) Allocation of Rs. 25,000/- to each Department for Summer Undergraduate research activity.
