Instructions /Information to candidates

1. Code of conduct should be strictly followed.
2. Candidature will be cancelled if the candidate is found to be guilty of breach of code of conduct.
3. Security amount will also be forfeited in case of cancellation of candidature due to breach of code of conduct or if candidate is found involving in any act of indiscipline.
4. Security amount will be forfeited if the candidate fails to secure minimum 10% of the total valid votes polled.
5. An open house will be held on Monday September 09, 2019 at 11:45 AM in the New Seminar Hall. Each Mayer candidate will address students gathering for 15 minutes. After his/her speech, each student will be allowed to ask one question per candidate. The question session will remain open for 10 minutes.
6. All candidates can depute their observers in all polling booths on the day of polling i.e. Tuesday, 12th September 2019 from 9:15 A.M. till the end of polling i.e. 01:00 P.M.
7. Observers on behalf of the candidates (but not the candidates) can also witness the counting of votes on the same day i.e. 12th September 2019, 2:30 P.M. onwards till the completion of counting.
8. Names of Observers along with their class and contact no. should be given to either of the Election Officers, Ms. Sadhna Gupta, Dr. Anju Agrawal, Dr. Manisha Verma, Dr. Yasheshwar on or before 11th September 2019.
9. Any suggestions, information or complaint may be submitted to Mr. Yask Sain and Mr. Ankit Singh, Dept of Commerce.
10. All matters related to Students' Council Election will come under the jurisdiction of the ANDC Students Council Election Committee 2019

Code of Conduct

1. Candidate shall spend maximum of Rs. 1000/- only on campaigning.
2. All candidates shall have to submit the statement of expenses to the Election Officer(s).
3. Only Hand-made bills with maximum size of half of the A-4 papers should be used.
4. Classes shall not be disturbed in any way during campaigning.
5. The Campaigning timings for candidates are 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 P.M. and shall be strictly followed.
6. All the bills/pamphlets/charts for campaigning shall be displayed on “**The Wall of Democracy**” and on canteen notice board only.
7. Candidates are prohibited to offer any kind of party/ refreshment /gifts to the college students.
8. Any means of Public Address System such as Microphone/Audio Amplifiers/Sound system or Recorded Music/Songs/Band/*Dhol*etc cannot be used for campaigning.
9. Maximum Group size of supporters during campaigning for a candidate is limited to 10 and in no circumstances could be increased beyond the prescribed limit.
10. The candidates should ensure that their campaigning should not result in any kind of littering in the college premises.
11. No candidate is allowed to be present in and around the Polling Booths except exercising his/her voting right.
